

Container Detention Policy

To ensure Pacifica Shipping has containers available to meet demand, we require uplift and return of containers within the free time period outlined.

(Rates quoted in NZ dollars, per day or part thereof subject to gst)

<u>Origin Free day period</u> commences from day the container has been collected from the depot . In the case of re-use containers, the free time period is 7 days prior to cargo cut-off

<u>Destination free time period</u> commences from the day after the container has been discharged from the vessel.

Detention charges will apply when a container is not uplifted or returned in accordance with the below listed criteria:

- Not shipped with Pacifica's services within the specified free-time period of uplifting MT container.
- Not returned to Pacifica's nominated de-hire point within the specified free-time at destination port.
- Any container that is not returned to Pacifica within 60 days will be regarded as missing, and the shipper will be held liable for the value of the container any detention charges incurred.
